Lesson Learned

Especially the group building process must be simplified by making participants familiar with the concept of self-organisation.

0] Preparation



- write your skills and interests on your card
- go to a free poster and reserve left or right side
- stick your card to the upper edge
- note your project-ideas below the card
- keep space for some other cards at the lower part of the poster

If you think about your skills and interests, on what project-idea(s) would you use them?



1] Poster Tour



- take a tour to the posters
- see if you can find something, that you can **support, complement** or **combine** with something from you.
- stick your card to the posters, which you are interested in



2] Idea Wall



- join your group at the idea wall
- work out a project idea - write your notes directly on the wall!
- join (optionally) up to three groups (15 minutes each)



3] Panel Discussion



- get insights into various ideas on the wall
- discuss and bring in further ideas, knowledge, comments and conclusions



Lesson Learned

Participants love the idea wall as shared space to give others insights into the outcomes of the group works.

Facilitators have to find the right balance between free space and guidance.
